**NOTICE TO USER:** This pest control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on the label. It is an offence under the *Pest Control Products Act* to use this product in a way that is inconsistent with the directions on the label. The user assumes the risk to persons or property that arises from any such use of this product.

**NATURE OF RESTRICTION:** For use by authorized customers where the vendor maintains a record of sales, including the name and address of the purchaser, amount purchased together with a signed Notice to Purchaser.

**RESTRICTED USE:** DEFIANCE BEAR DETERRENT is designed to be used in wilderness applications to help defend individuals needing assistance when confronted by bears. This product is for spraying the face of aggressive bears only and is not to be used against domestic animals or human beings. This product has an effective range up to 6 metres (20 feet). The canister empties in approximately 8 seconds.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** Special procedures must be followed to arm the container, apply the product and restore the safety clip to disarm the container. Before taking this product into bear country, read the directions below and familiarize yourself with these procedures. If you test-fire this container, make sure to discharge downwind and do not depress the actuator tab for more than one-half a second. Do not test-fire in areas inhabited by bears. After test firing, clean nozzle and can with soap and water to remove all residues from the can.

**TO ARM AND APPLY:** Slide orange safety clip back completely. Aim at the face of the bear. Press activation tab down using short bursts. Avoid discharging upwind. Move away from area of discharge.

**TO DISARM:** Replace orange safety clip by firmly pushing with thumb until audible “snap” is heard. Check to see if safety clip is securely in place. No gap should be visible between the actuator handle and the safety clip.

**PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Capsicum is a bronchial constrictant. Wash hands before touching eyes or face and prior to using the washroom. If you have irritated eyes or difficulty breathing, seek immediate medical attention. Capsaicin sprays have been proven effective in repelling bears only when sprayed directly in the eyes or on the nose. This product should be used only as a last resort. There is no guaranteed method of responding to a bear encounter, each encounter is unique. Strict attention to the advice of wildlife professionals on safety is advised.

This product is for spraying the face of aggressive bears only and is not to be used against domestic animals or human beings.

Capsaicin sprays will not repel bears from treated objects or areas. Do not spray objects (e.g. tents, clothing) or areas with this product.

Severe irritation to eyes, nose, respiratory and skin areas can occur. Use only in outdoor areas. Persons with respiratory problems or wearing contact lenses should not use this product. Avoid contact with skin and eyes and avoid inhalation of spray.

**WHEN TRAVELLING DO NOT STORE IN PASSENGER COMPARTMENT.** Contact air carriers for regulations concerning air transport. Contents under pressure. Container may explode if heated. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat. Do not leave in hot vehicle. For safety and performance, do not store above 50°C or below 0°C. Be careful not to puncture container.

**DO NOT INCINERATE THE CONTAINER.**

Use of this product for any purpose other than self-defense against bear attacks is a criminal offense.

**FIRST AID:** In case of external contact, **REMAIN CALM**, flush thoroughly with water. **DO NOT RUB. IF IN EYES**, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED**, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF INHALED**, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Capsicum is a bronchial constrictant. Symptoms usually disappear within one hour.

Take the container label or product name and PCP Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Treat symptomatically.

**DISPOSAL:** When the container is empty, press valve to release all pressure. Dispose of empty container in accordance with Provincial requirements. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted products, contact your Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.
