DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Sylvanex Flakes is to be used on freshly felled lodgepole pine and red pine logs as a preventative treatment against sapstain.

1. Preparation of the Sylvanex suspension:

First determine the volume in litres of Sylvanex suspension required for daily operation by multiplying the total surface area in square metres of logs to be treated by 0.54L. Then, determine the quantity of Sylvanex Flakes to be added to the water by using the following formula:

Number of grams of Sylvanex Flakes required =

[Volume, in litres of Sylvanex suspension required for daily operation] $X 50 \div$ [label guarantee (in AU/kg)*].

*NOTE: Sylvanex Flakes label guarantee may change from container to container.

Weigh the required quantity of dried Sylvanex Flakes and rehydrate it by mixing it with water that is 4-30°C and has a pH 5-8. Use a stirrer to get a vortex. Allow sufficient time for the mixture to become homogeneous before using it. The final Sylvanex suspension will have a concentration of 0.05 AU per litre (5.0 x 1010 CFU per litre). Use the diluted mixture of Sylvanex within 24 hours of mixing.

2. Application of Sylvanex:

The 0.05 AU/L suspension of Sylvanex is to be applied to logs immediately after the harvesting of the wood and cutting/delimbing of branches. The entire surface of each log must be sprayed at a rate of 540 mL per square metre of log surface. A hydraulic spray system, attached to the various cutting and delimbing equipment, must be used for application at the logging site.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May cause sensitization.

Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes plus socks, and water-proof gloves and eye-goggles when handling, mixing/loading or applying the product, and during all clean-up and repair activities. Wash exposed areas of skin thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. **DO NOT** apply directly to water. **DO NOT** contaminate water by cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

FIRST AID:

IF ON SKIN/CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Wash exposed skin with plenty of soap and water.

IF INHALED: Move to fresh air.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water. Remove contact lenses, if present, then continue rinsing eye.
