PRECAUTIONS HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS

DANGER KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Causes skin burns. Harmful if inhaled. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Aspiration may cause lung damage. Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

AQUAGUARD 660 solutions are incompatible with many commonly used materials of construction such as steel, galvanized iron, aluminum, tin, and zinc. These solutions can be stored and handled in baked phenolic-lined steel, polyethylene, stainless steel, or reinforced epoxy-plastic equipment. This product freezes at about -17EC. Therefore, unless the storage is inside or underground, heating and insulation may be required. If heating is needed, exposure to high temperatures should be avoided. For short storage times (up to about 1 month) temperatures up to 38 C can be tolerated bu the preferred maximum storage temperature is about 27 C.

A stainless steel centrifugal pump is suggested for transfer

service. Spiral wound stainless steel with TEFLON is suitable for gaskets and packing.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE AIR WASHERS AND INDUSTRIAL SCRUBBING SYSTEMS/RECIRCULATING COOLING AND PROCESS WATER SYSTEMS

This product may be used in industrial air washers and air washer systems which have mist-eliminating components. AQUAGUARD 660 should be added at the application rates described below, to a water treatment system at a convenient point of uniform mixing such as the basin area. Additions may be made intermittently (slug dose) or continuously. Badly fouled systems can be shock treated with AQUAGUARD 660. Under these conditions blowdown should be discontinued for up to 24 hours.

AQUAGUARD 660 can be used in industrial process water systems that contain ultra filtration units and non-medical reverse osmosis membranes (where approved for compatibility by the membrane manufacturer) and associated distribution systems.

INTERMITTENT (SLUG DOSE) METHOD

Initial Dose: When the system is noticeably fouled, apply 111 mL to 444 mL of AQUAGUARD 660 per 1000 litres of water in the system. Repeat until control is achieved.

Subsequent Dose: When microbial control is evident, add 33 mL to 111 mL of AQUAGUARD 660 per 1000 litres of water in the system weekly, or as needed to maintain control.

Badly fouled systems must be cleaned before treatment is

begun.

CONTINUOUS FEED METHOD

Initial Dose: When the system is noticeably fouled, apply 111 mL to 444 mL of AQUAGUARD 660 per 1000 litres of water in the system.

Subsequent Dose: Maintain this treatment level by starting a continuous feed of 16 mL to 333 mL of AQUAGUARD 660 per 1000 litres of water in the system per day.

Badly fouled systems must be cleaned before treatment is begun.

SERVICE WATER AND AUXILIARY SYSTEMS

AQUAGUARD 660 should be used at the same application rates, and in the same manner as described above. It should be added to the system at a point that will allow for uniform mixing throughout the system.

HEAT TRANSFER SYSTEMS

(Evaporative Condensors, Dairy Sweetwater Systems, Hydrostatic sterilizers and Retorts, and Pasteurizers and Warmers and Once-through Cooling Water Systems)

AQUAGUARD 660 should be used at the same application rates, and in the same manner as described above. It should be added to the system at a point of uniform mixing such as a basin area, sump area, or other reservoir collecting area from which the treated water will be circulated uniformly throughout the system.

INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER SYSTEMS

(Wastewater Systems, Wastewater Sludge, and Wastewater Holding Tanks)

AQUAGUARD 660 should be added to a wastewater system or sludge at a convenient point of uniform mixing such as the digester. Add 0.5 litres to 2.5 litres (500 to 2500 ppm AQUAGUARD 660) per 1000 litres of wastewater or sludge.

DISPOSAL

- 1) Triple or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
- 2) Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to it's disposal.

- 3) Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
- 4) Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
- 5) For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill and for clean-up of spills.
