### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

To be used only in the manufacturing of antimicrobial products registered under the *Pest Control Products Act* or products exempt from registration under Schedule II of the *Pest Control Products Act*. Manufacturer is responsible for their own registrations.

#### PRECAUTIONS.

DANGER: PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

- 1) Dangerous gas formed when mixed with acid.
- 2) Do not mix with any other chemical.
- 3) Corrosive to eyes and to skin. DO NOT get in eyes, on skin or clothing.
- 4) May be fatal if swallowed.
- 5) Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing vapour or mist.
- 6) Wear goggles or a face shield, chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long sleeved shirt, shoes and socks when handling this product.

#### FIRST AID:

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: call IMMEDIATELY a poison control centre or doctor IMMEDIATELY for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
