DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*. Use only for formulation into end-use products designed for application to human skin and clothing for the purpose of repelling mosquitoes and black flies.

FIRST AID:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 – 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 – 20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

PRECAUTIONS: PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

STORAGE:
