### **PRECAUTIONS:**

Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive to eyes and skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not inhale vapors or mist. Use only in well ventilated areas. Do not wear contact lenses. Workers must wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, chemical resistant gloves and goggles or a face shield during mixing, loading, clean-up and repair. When handling the concentrate, wear full face protection with cartridge respirator and chemical resistant gloves, apron, cap and boots. Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining personal protective equipment. If no such instructions exist for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash personal protective equipment separately from other laundry. Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. ### **DISPOSAL:**

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

**APPLICATION:** The following use levels (% by weight) are for Polyphase PW20 addition to exterior and interior paints for dry-film preservation. In order to determine the most cost effective use level for Polyphase PW20 in a given use, field trials, performed within the label rate are suggested.

Exterior paint (solvent): 0.5-1.5%

Exterior paint (latex): 1.0-2.5%

Interior paint: 0.2-0.8%

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies for aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. DO NOT discharge effluents containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

### **USE LIMITATIONS:**
