Section 2: Precautions, Protective Clothing and Equipment

PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

Causes eye irritation. DO NOT get in eyes. Potential skin sensitizer. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Prolonged or frequent repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Section 4: Environmental Hazards

TOXIC to aquatic organisms. DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

Section 5: STORAGE

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
