### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a fungicide which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act* or for industry incorporation into paints to control fungal growth.

### PRECAUTIONS:

**PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.** CORROSIVE to the eye. Do not get in eyes. Potential skin sensitizer. Store in a cool, dry, ventilated place, away from feeds and foods. Keep away from heat, fire and sparks. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse. Avoid breathing dust or spray mist. When treating, augering, or handling treated seed, work in a well-ventilated area and wear a suitable dust mask, goggles and gloves. Do not contaminate food or feed. Do not contaminate any body of water.

### FIRST AID:

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

### IF IN EYES:

Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take the container label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Treat symptomatically.

**STORAGE:** Keep in original container during storage. Store product in cool, dry, well ventilated place away from seed, feed, fertilizer or other pesticides. Keep away from fire or open flame or other sources of heat.

### DECONTAMINATION AND DISPOSAL:

Canadian formulators using this product should dispose of unwanted active ingredient and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations.
