DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

DO NOT apply when swimmers are in the immediate vicinity (a 15 minute restricted-entry interval is recommended)

1. Initial dosage is 20 mL of Dazzle Algae Resist 50 per 10,000 L of pool water. Initial dose is used when filling the pool.
2. Maintenance dosage is 10 mL per 10,000 L every week. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently. Maintenance dose should be added after a heavy or prolonged rainfall.
3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorinating product employed and wait at least 24 hours before adding maintenance dosage.
4. For pool water having visible algae, when super-chlorination is not employed, add 40 mL of Dazzle Algae Resist 50 per 10,000 L of pool water.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. DANGER-CORROSIVE. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes skin or on clothing. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield or safety glasses), rubber gloves and protective clothing when handling. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get into eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. FIRST AID:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED : Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING : Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES : Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
