DIRECTIONS FOR USE

AGA 60 is for use in manufacturing, formulating or repackaging. It is to be used only for the manufacture of pesticid es which are registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

PRECAUTIONS

DANGER PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORISED PERSONNEL

Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with skin and clothing.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registra tion Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
