DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DASH HC spray tank adjuvant is a blend of surfactants and solvent type of agricultural spray designed for use with LIBERTY 150 SN Herbicide and Crop Desiccant MP on glufosinate ammonium tolerant canola..

Application Rates

LIBERTY 150 SN Herbicide and Crop Desiccant MP for use on glufosinate-ammonium tolerant canola only

Add **DASH HC Adjuvant** to spray applications of LIBERTY 150 SN Herbicide and Crop Desiccant MP at 0.5% v/v (5 L **DASH HC Adjuvant** per 1000 L total spray solution) when tank mixed with Centurion® Emulsifiable Concentrate Post-Emergence Herbicide or Centurion Emulsifiable Concentrate Post-Emergence Herbicide and Facet® L. Refer to the LIBERTY 150 SN Herbicide and Crop Desiccant MP label for detailed use instructions.

MIXING

1. Fill the spray tank about half full with water and add the required herbicide while the agitator is running or by-pass agitation is operating.
2. Add the required amount of **DASH HC Adjuvant** to the tank. Continue to agitate until thoroughly mixed.
3. Add the required amount of LIBERTY 150 SN Herbicide and Crop Desiccant MP to the spray tank. Continue to agitate until LIBERTY 150 SN Herbicide and Crop Desiccant MP is thoroughly mixed.
4. If required, add the correct amount of Facet L.
5. Add the correct amount of CENTURION Emulsifiable Concentrate Post-Emergence Herbicide along with the remaining amount of water necessary to fill the spray tank.
6. Continue to agitate or run the by-pass system and spray out immediately.
