DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Open package and remove single towelette. Immediately unfold Towelette and wipe a thin uniform film over all exposed skin. Apply sparingly not under clothing and only when necessary. Reapply after 6 hours if necessary. Repels mosquitoes for six hours. Also repels black flies, biting midges, deer flies, stable flies, ticks and chiggers. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and clothing. For ticks and chiggers apply to shoe tops, socks and areas around openings in clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid over exposure. Frequent re-application is not necessary for the product to work effectively. After returning indoors wash treated skin and clothing with soap and water.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. DO NOT USE ON CHILDREN UNDER 12 YEARS OF AGE. AVOID CONTACT WITH EYES AND MOUTH. Harmful if swallowed. For external use only.
