DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Sodium Omadine 40% Technical is sold for use in manufacturing formulations registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*. Formulators are responsible for their own registration of the formulated pest control products.

STORAGE: Do not store above 55 °C (130 °F). Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not store with strong oxidizing agents.

PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

Danger: Corrosive to eyes. Do not get in eyes. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact of the concentrate with skin. Wear goggles or face shield and coveralls during all activities involving use of this product. Wear chemical resistant gloves when handling the concentrate, and during cleanup and repair activities. FIRST AID:

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth- to- mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
