Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days or until there are no longer signs of new feeding by house mice.

FOLLOW-UP: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Using rubber gloves collect and dispose of all dead, exposed animals and leftover bait properly. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from other chemicals and food or feed. Store products not in use, in original container, in a secure location inaccessible to children and nontarget animals.
