DIRECTIONS: Shake well. Repels mosquitoes for up to 2 hours. Also repels black flies, biting midges, deer flies, stable flies, ticks, and chiggers. Apply sparingly not under clothing and only when necessary. Reapply after 2 hours if necessary. Spray clothing and exposed skin except face. TO APPLY TO FACE: Spray hands and apply, avoiding eyes and mouth. Do not spray in enclosed spaces.
