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DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a fungicide, which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL: May be hazardous if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water before eating, drinking or smoking and change to clean clothing. Keep away from domestic animals. Do not contaminate any body of water. Avoid contamination of feed, seed, fertilizers and foodstuffs. Store product in cool dry place. Do not reuse empty container.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed: call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 - 20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes: hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 - 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Systemic effects unknown. Treat symptomatically. Possible skin and eye irritation.
