DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 130 mL of POLY 30 per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 2. Weekly maintenance dosage is 45 mL of POLY 30 per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
- 4. For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 200 mL of POLY 30 per 10,000 L of pool water.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. Do not mix with any other chemical. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

DISPOSAL:
