Shake Well Before Using

GENERAL INFORMATION: Scent-a-Gone Animal Repellent Liquid Concentrate contains ingredients that irritate listed animals when they touch or taste the product. It can be used to repel dogs, cats, groundhogs, skunks, raccoons and squirrels from treated areas for up to 30 days. Shake well before mixing. This product can be applied using all types of hand or power sprayers. Read and carefully follow the instructions for the type of sprayer you use. Promptly clean all equipment after each use. Do not mix or apply this product with equipment that has been used for herbicide applications. Properly dilute and spray Scent-a-Gone Animal Repellent Liquid Concentrate on all areas to be protected.

This product will stain structural surfaces and painted surfaces. Do not apply to siding, roofing, decks, fences, driveways, painted surfaces (including automobiles), sidewalks or other structural material and architectural surfaces. Do not allow spray to drift onto structural surfaces in the areas of application.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY

Do not apply to food or feed crops.

Apply only to dry surfaces, and only under conditions favouring prompt drying of spray (lightly breezy), mild dry weather with low relative humidity.

Mixing and Dilution Instructions:

Do not use kitchen utensils for measuring!

Keep measuring utensils with pest control products out of reach of children.

Mix before using: Scent-a-Gone Animal Repellent Liquid Concentrate must be mixed with water to produce ready-to-use spray. Before mixing, read and understand mixing instructions.

Use promptly after mixing: Do not store mixed solution longer than one day. Carefully determine the quantity required for immediate application.

Before diluting, thoroughly shake or stir contents of concentrate container to completely re-suspend all solids.

In a suitable mixing container, mix 1 part concentrate with 7 parts warm water (473mL of concentrate makes 3.3 litres of spray when mixed with water).

Pour dilute spray into sprayer and use promptly. Stir or shake the spray immediately before use and frequently during use to prevent settling in bottom of sprayer. Run agitator on large tank sprayers. If sprayer is to be re-used, clean with cold water immediately after use.

Seal tightly: If saving part of unmixed concentrate for use later, close container tightly to prevent evaporation.

Landscaped Areas, including lawns, gardens and ornamentals:

Scent-a-Gone Animal Repellent Liquid Concentrate can be used:

- To discourage digging by cats, dogs, raccoons, skunks and squirrels in landscaped areas.
- To discourage unwanted cats, dogs, raccoons, squirrels, groundhogs and skunks from entering lawns and gardens
- To discourage damage to ornamental plantings by cats, dogs, groundhogs and squirrels

Spray diluted product thoroughly until wet or until run-off. Lightly apply a second application after the first application has dried. Apply product to soil, mulch, lawns and ornamental plants. Reapply every 30 days or as needed when repellency appears to fade. More frequent application may be necessary during periods of heavy, prolonged rainfall.

Do not apply product directly to new transplants, newly rooted cuttings or plants stressed by drought. Avoid application to plants when temperature exceeds 30° C. Before full-scale application to plants, test spray an inconspicuous area and wait 24 hours to observe for damage.

Garbage Bags and Garbage Containers:

To reduce frequent tearing of garbage bags and disturbance of containers by cats, dogs, raccoons and squirrels, spray the diluted product thoroughly until wet over the entire bag and container. Lightly apply a second application after the first application has dried. Treat garbage bags within 72 hours of pickup. Re-apply to garbage containers every 30 days or as needed when repellency appears to fade. More frequent application may be necessary during periods of heavy, prolonged rainfall.

Bird Feeders:

To discourage the raiding of bird feeders by squirrels, wet area around bird feeder, including pole, branches and tree trunk. Bird feeders can also be sprayed directly. To test for staining of wooden or plastic birdfeeders, spray an inconspicuous area prior to treating entire feeder. Apply diluted product thoroughly until wet. Lightly apply a second application after the first application has dried. Re-apply every 30 days or as needed when repellency appears to fade. More frequent application may be necessary during periods of heavy, prolonged rainfall.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May irritate the skin. Potential skin sensitizer. If ingested, a bitter taste and burning sensation will result. Avoid ingestion and contact with eyes or skin. The use of waterproof gloves, a slong-sleeved shirt, pants, shoes and socks when diluting, mixing and applying this product. Wash hands with soap and water after use, before touching eyes or face and prior to using the washroom. Store in a cool area away from heat and light. Do not smoke or eat while applying. Application of Scent-a-Gone Animal Repellent Liquid Concentrate is not known to harm ornamental plants. DO NOT USE ON FOOD OR EDIBLE PLANTS, OR WHERE CHILDREN WILL PLAY. KEEP CHILDREN AND PETS AWAY FROM SITES OF APPLICATION UNTIL SPRAYED SOLUTION HAS DRIED.

FIRST AID:

If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap empty container in newspaper and place in household garbage.
