GENERAL INFORMATION

Description: Repels mosquitoes. Comfort Zone is a ready-to-use, strong garlic solution that is sprayed on plants, shrubs, and turf to repel mosquitoes.

How it works: Mosquitoes are repelled by the odour of Comfort Zone almost immediately after spraying.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Shake well before using. For best results spray in early morning or early evening. Spray until run-off. Use in areas that attract mosquitoes such as grass, plants, shrubs and under decks and porches. The repelling effect of Comfort Zone lasts up to 5 days. Re-apply after heavy rain or if mosquitoes continue to be a problem. Application to vinyl or aluminum siding or other porous surface may result in staining or discoloration. Avoid application to a surface that is exposed to direct sunlight or during the heat of the day. Prior to use on or near a porous surface such as a wood deck, treat a small area and evaluate 30 minutes later for potential staining.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not swallow. Avoid getting on skin and in eyes. May cause skin and eye irritation. Avoid inhaling/breathing mist or vapours. Potential skin sensitizer.

Apply only when the potential for drift is minimal. Individuals who are sensitive or allergic to garlic should avoid handling Comfort Zone Individuals who are sensitive or allergic to garlic should avoid treated areas until dry or after a heavy rain.

FIRST AID

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE

To prevent contamination store this product away from food or feed.

DISPOSAL

DO NOT reuse the empty containers. Dispose in household garbage. Unused or partially used products should be disposed at provincially or municipally designated hazardous waste disposal sites.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE OF EZSPRAY™ TRIGGER SPRAYER:

EZSPRAY™ EASY SET UP (5 illustrations)

- 1. Remove sprayer from side holder. Gently pull tubing.*
- 2. Remove seal from top of cap. Remove plug from cap.*
- 3. Securely snap the plug on end of tubing into hole on cap.*
- 4. Remove plastic tab near bottom to activate batteries.*
- 5. Twist nozzle to adjust spray from CLOSE to SPRAY to STREAM.*

HOW TO USE THE EZSPRAY™

- A. Aim toward target and away from people and pets.*
- B. Press the trigger to spray.*
- C. Release the trigger to stop spray.*

After use: 1. Twist nozzle completely to CLOSE position. 2. Secure sprayer upright in holder. 3. Failure to adjust nozzle completely to CLOSE position and properly secure sprayer in holder may result in leakage and damage to property or injury to people or animals.

To replace batteries: **1.** Slide battery compartment door to unlatch and open. **2.** Remove used batteries and insert four new AA batteries in correct positions as marked per diagram inside of battery compartment. Never insert the positive end where the negative end belongs and vice versa. Always use a complete set of new batteries of the same type when replacing batteries.

Never mix alkaline, carbon-zinc or rechargeable batteries. **3.** Securely close battery compartment door. **4. Always** follow manufacturer's recommendations for use and disposal of batteries.

Additional Operating Notes: • Do not submerge in water. • Before each use, inspect sprayer carefully. Make sure hose is flexible and not kinked, worn or cracked, and that all connections are tight. • When storing sprayer for prolonged periods remove batteries.
