Established dandelion, crabgrass (smooth and large) and white clover at the time of application will not be inhibited. This product is formulated for use in residential lawns where established perennial ryegrass and Kentucky bluegrass are the predominant grass species.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Apply this product to dry or moist soil. Do not apply to excessively saturated soil. Do not apply if rain is forecasted within 24 hours after application. Do not irrigate for 24 hours after application. Excessive moisture at the time of application may reduce the effectiveness of the product. Do not apply under windy conditions. Application dates may vary for both spring and late summer/early fall applications from year to year according to weather conditions. DO NOT apply to any body of water. METHOD OF APPLICATION:

INSTRUCTIONS FOR HOSE END ATTACHMENT CONTAINERS

- 1. Shake container thoroughly, then attach to garden hose.
- 2. Turn water supply on at the source. Water pressure will build in hose since the sprayer is already in the "OFF" position.
- 3. To apply product, bend safety tab and turn the control valve clockwise to the "ON" position.
- 4. For best results, hold sprayer and bottle level, and direct spray in a sweeping side-to-side movement. Spray the contents of bottle evenly over the lawn surface. Refer to the "Application Rate" section of this label for the application rate and treatment areas. Do not overlap areas already sprayed.
- 5. To spray water only, turn the control valve clockwise so that the valve indicator arrow is pointing to "WATER" position on the sprayer.

6. When spraying is complete, turn the control valve to "OFF" position. Turn water off. Disconnect hose from applicator and store product in original container.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR 10 L CONTAINER REQUIRING HAND-HELD OR BACKPACK SPRAYER Open container and slowly pour 1 part Wilson® WeedOut® Preventer into any standard hand-held or backpack sprayer containing 3 parts water (example: pour 1 L product into 3 L water). Apply the mixed solution at a rate of 43 mL/m². At this rate, a 10 L container of product will treat 930 m2 (10,000 ft²). Direct the spray in a sweeping side-to-side movement over the lawn surface. Do not overlap areas already sprayed.
