PRECAUTIONS:

DISPOSAL:

Do not re-use empty container. Wrap and dispose of empty container with household garbage. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.

FIRST-AID:

If In Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If On Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If Swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Enclosed scoop holds 10 grams of EZCHLOR. Before using spa, test chlorine or bromine level.

If Chlorine or Bromine level is EZCHLOR required per 1,000 litres

0 - 1.0 ppm 20 grams (2 scoops)

1.0 - 3.0 ppm 10 grams (1 scoop)

over 3.0 ppm 0

After using spa add 20 grams (2 scoops) of EZCHLOR per 1,000 litres. Run circulating pump for 15-30 minutes.

Heavy use may cause a demand for additional EZCHLOR to maintain the desirable 3.0 ppm minimum level.

SPA-START-UP:

1. Before filling spa have water tested by your Hydropool dealer.
2. Fill spa and follow dealers directions to balance water.

SPA REGULAR CARE:

1. Test pH and Chlorine or Bromine daily.
2. Test Total Alkalinity weekly and adjust with SPA-BUFFER or SPA-DOWN.
3. Add SPA-GLO weekly to prevent staining and mineral deposits and to keep spa water sparkling clear.
4. Add BUBBLE-BURST as required to control the formation of foam.
