Mint-X Treated Compostable Plastic is to be used in the manufacture of trash bags with the claim of reducing the number of trash bags torn by Norway rats and raccoons compared to standard trash bags. Labels of trash bags manufactured using Mint-X Treated Compostable Plastic must have the following statements:

"These trash bags contain Mint-X Treated Compostable Plastic (Reg. No. 31383; 0.288% methyl salicylate, 0.288% cornmint oil, 0.184% camphor oil, 0.04% eucalyptus oil) which reduces the number of trash bags torn by Norway rats and raccoons compared to standard trash bags. The performance of the product will depend on a variety of factors (e.g., habituation by pest, availability of alternative food sources, contents of trash bag). Mint-X Treated Compostable Plastic is to be used for the disposal of trash. **DO NOT USE MINT-X TREATED COMPOSTABLE PLASTIC FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSES, INCLUDING FOOD STORAGE.**"

The claim of "Mint Scented" and "Reduces the number of trash bags torn by Norway rats and raccoons" may also appear on the label of the trash bags manufactured using Mint-X Treated Compostable Plastic.
