PRECAUTIONS - KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

FIRST AID

GENERAL USE RESTRICTIONS

- Do not remain in freshly treated area and ventilate the area after the treatment is completed.
- Do not contaminate water, food, or foodstuffs. Remove all pets and birds. Cover fish tanks or remove before spraying.
- Do not use this product in electrical equipment (where there is exposed wiring or contact points) due to possibility of short circuits and shock hazard. Do not spray directly into any electronic equipment such as radios, televisions, computers, etc.
- Do not spray on plastic (including but not limited to vinyl), painted, or varnished surfaces.
- Product should only be used when can temperature is above 16°C. If can temperature is below 16°C, store at room temperature until a temperature above 16°C is reached.
- Although MotherEarth Crawling Insect Killer is not expected to damage most substrates, it is recommended that a small, inconspicuous area be tested prior to treating an entire area in case of adverse effects.

HOW TO USE BASF CRACK AND CREVICE® INJECTION SYSTEM

MotherEarth Crawling Insect Killer works best on contact. Contact as many insects as possible when making a Crack and Crevice or spot application.

CRACK & CREVICE® TREATMENT: Use MotherEarth Crawling Insect Killer only with the supplied actuators and injection tubes or BASF Equipment™ System III®. Inject MotherEarth Crawling Insect Killer into cracks and crevices or void spaces where insects may be living and breeding. Place injector tip into cracks, crevices, holes and other small openings. Release approximately one second of product. For light infestations, move injector tip along cracks while treating at the rate of 1m/sec. For heavy infestations, move injector tip along at 35 cm/sec. For closed voids, calculate the void's cubic area and treat at the rate of 1 - 5 sec/m³. Several holes may be required in long-running voids. Reapply as needed.

DIRECTED CONTACT TREATMENT: Spot treatment applications may only be made outdoors, in commercial kitchens, garages, attics or unfinished basement areas. Use MotherEarth Crawling Insect Killer only with the supplied actuators and injection tubes or BASF Equipment System III. Hold container upright while spraying. Direct nozzle approximately 30 cm from surface to be treated. Apply directly on insects in these locations when possible. Reapply as needed.

INDOOR TREATMENTS

FOR USE IN THE FOLLOWING INDOOR SITES: Apartments†, Food Storage Areas, Homes†, Hospitals††, Hotels, Meat Packing and Food Processing Plants†, Motels, Nursing Homes††, Resorts, Restaurants and other Food Handling Establishments†, Schools†††, Supermarkets†, Transportation Equipment (Buses, Boats, Ships, Trains, Trucks), Utilities, Warehouses, and other Commercial and Industrial Buildings.

CENTIPEDES, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, MILLIPEDES AND SPIDERS: Apply as a Crack & Crevice treatment using the prescribed dosage into cracks, crevices and void spaces where insects may be harboring. These may include, but are not limited to, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, behind baseboards, washing machines, stoves, cabinets, sewers, floor drains and meter boxes. Reapply as needed.

TICKS: Apply as a Crack & Crevice treatment into infested and egg laying sites near pet resting areas including, but not limited to, cracks and crevices of baseboards and around door and window frames.

FLEAS: Hold container tilted down away from your face and, with a sweeping side-to-side motion, kill adult fleas hidden in dog and cat bedding and under furniture. Before spraying, test an inconspicuous corner of fabric for staining. Reapply as needed.

BED BUGS: Apply to cracks and crevices where evidence of bed bugs occurs. This includes bed frames, box springs, inside empty dressers and clothes closets, carpet edges, high and low wall moldings and wallpaper edges. Do not use this product on mattresses, pillows, bed linens or clothes. Remove all clothes and other articles from dressers or clothes closets before application. Allow all treated areas to dry thoroughly before use. Not recommended for use as sole protection against bed bugs. If evidence of bed bugs is found in/on mattresses, use a product approved for this use.

ASIAN LADY BEETLES, CLUSTER FLIES AND FLOUR BEETLES: Apply as a Crack & Crevice treatment into cracks, crevices and/or voids where these insects may be harboring or hibernating. Infested areas may include, but are not limited to, cracks and crevices in cabinets and pantries, wall voids, around window and door frames, under siding and in machinery. Reapply as needed.

APPLICATIONS IN FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

Food handling establishments are places other than private residences in which food is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOR USE IN THE FOLLOWING FOOD HANDLING SITES: Food Storage Areas, Meat Packing and Food Processing Plants, Restaurants and other Food Handling Establishments. (NOTE: Exposed food must be covered or removed.)

FOOD AREAS: Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation) are also considered food areas. Apply as a Crack & Crevice Treatment or Spot Treatment (in kitchen area only) directly into cracks, crevices, voids or onto surfaces where insects are resting. Use only with the supplied actuators and injection tubes or BASF System Equipment System VII. Apply to different elements of construction; between equipment and floor; openings leading to hollow spaces in walls; equipment legs and bases; and where insects hide or rest. Do not apply directly to food. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces and equipment should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before using. When using this product, apply only when plant is not in operation. Repeat treatment as necessary.

NON-FOOD AREAS: Includes areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage areas (after canning or bottling). Infested areas may include, but are not limited to, cracks and crevices, behind siding, wall voids, around window and door frames. Reapply as needed.

OUTDOOR TREATMENTS

FOR USE AROUND THE FOLLOWING SITES: Apartments, Campgrounds, Homes, Hospitals, Hotels, Motels, Nursing Homes, Resorts, Schools, Supermarkets, Utilities, Warehouses, and other Commercial and Industrial Buildings.

PERIMETER TREATMENT: For centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, millipedes and spiders, apply MotherEarth Crawling Insect Killer as a Crack & Crevice or Spot Treatment into cracks and crevices where insects may be entering premises or harboring. Areas to be treated may include, but are not limited to, weep holes, under siding, wall voids, soffits, around attic vents, cracks and crevices and openings around windows, doors and pipes. Repeat treatment as necessary.

TREATMENT FOR IN-GROUND SERVICE BOXES: For Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Millipedes and Spiders. Use BASF spray actuator with injection tube to treat open boxes and exposed surfaces. Reapply as needed. Do not contact any electrical wiring or mechanical parts of meter.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: To prevent contamination, store this product away from food or feed.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press valve to release all remaining pressure. Dispose of empty container in accordance with provincial requirements.
