DIRECTIONS FOR INDOOR USE

Remove pets, birds and fish bowls. Open cabinets and doors in the area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing.

TO OPERATE VALVE

Can be used manually or valve can be locked in open position. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, depress valve lever down firmly until it clicks and stays depressed. For best results, treat the distant rooms first by spraying towards ceiling using the manual setting. A 4 to 6 seconds spray is ample for average-sized (3m x 3m x 3m) room. Also, spray into crack, crevices and other areas where the insects may hide prior to spraying towards the ceiling. Place can on stand or table in centre of unobstructed area, then lock valve down in the open position. Leave building at once and keep building closed for 2 hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and ventilate for 30 minutes.

To kill bed bugs, spray mattress lightly, particularly around seams and tufts. Take beds apart, spray bed frame and springs including all joints. Also, spray into crack, crevices and other areas where the bed bugs may hide.

Repeat spraying in 2 weeks or when insects listed on this label are a problem. If possible, apply directly to the insect pest. This product will kill exposed insects only and has no residual control activity.

Do not use in food storage, handling, and serving areas as a total release bomb with valve locked open.

FOR OUTDOOR AND GARDEN USE

Spray with valve in manual position. For use to control listed insect pests on ornamental plants (such as asters, azaleas, begonias, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, gladioli, irises, marigolds, petunias, roses, and snapdragons), evergreens, small ornamental deciduous trees, shrubs and vines. This product will kill exposed insects only and has no residual control activity.

For best results, spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use a slow, sweeping

motion. Keep can 45 cm from plants. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray rows at the rate of 30 cm per second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat when insects listed on this label are a problem. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray garden when temperatures exceed 32°C.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents are under pressure. Exposure to prolonged sunlight or other sources of heat may cause bursting. Do not throw into fire, incinerator or store at temperature above 50°C. Do not spray on walls, composition tile or plastic. Do not spray over exposed food. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not spray into or near any open flame.

FIRST AID

IF ON SKIN/CLOTHING:

Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES:

Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED:

Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, and then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give **any** liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
