## DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a plant growth regulator which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act. Read technical bulletin for formulation details.

## PRECAUTIONS:

### PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

May be fatal if inhaled. Avoid inhaling/breathing dusts. Severely irritating to the eye. DO NOT get in eyes. Wear safety goggles when handling. Wear an approved respirator when handling large amounts. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking.

Do not contaminate irrigation water.

## FIRST AID:

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
