PRECAUTIONS:

Use 0.08% to 0.2%

GROUTS, CAULKS AND SEALANTS (In-can and dry-film protection)

For water-based grouts, silicone-based caulks, water-borne and latex-based sealants, use 0.2% to 0.3%

JOINT CEMENTS (In-can and dry-film protection)

Use 0.02% to 0.5%
