DIRECTIONS FOR USE: To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act. Formulators are responsible for their own registrations.

Avoid any contact with flaming or burning material, such as a lighted cigarette. Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. May be fatal if inhaled. FIRST AID :

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE:

Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or flame.
