To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act. USE LIMITATIONS: Not to be used in the manufacture of any wood, paper or paperboard that will come into contact with food.

## **PRECAUTIONS**

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. DANGER: CORROSIVE TO EYES AND CAUSES SKIN BURNS. MAY CAUSE ALLERGIC SKIN REACTION. MAY BE FATAL IF SWALLOWED OR ABSORBED THROUGH THE SKIN.
