- 1. Wind and other conditions may cause the flame to go out. Restart the torch if flame is not visible through the view window.
 - If the torch won't [turn on][light] or stay [on][lit]:
 - a. Confirm that the fuel cartridge [canister] is not empty;
 - b. Ensure the fuel cartridge is fully threaded into the fuel port;
 - c. Listen for fuel flow to ensure fuel is properly running;
 - d. Turn the torch to the START position [confirming you hear a click].

To Assemble Torch Pole:
