DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a microbiocide product which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

PRECAUTIONS: PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. CORROSIVE. CAUSES SEVERE EYE AND SKIN DAMAGE. Potential skin sensitizer. May cause an allergic skin reaction. FATAL OR POISONOUS IF SWALLOWED OR ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN. DO NOT get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. May be fatal if inhaled. DO NOT inhale/breathe sprays, vapours or dust. Avoid contamination of food. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

FIRST AID:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take the container label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be required.
