DIRECTIONS FOR USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

INDOOR APPLICATION: For spot application only. Do not use as a space spray or broadcast application indoors. **SURFACE SPRAYING** – To control **Ants:** Direct the spray into hiding places, cracks and crevices, behind shelves and drawers, along baseboards, beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets. Spray trails, nests and points of entry.

OUTDOOR APPLICATION: Ants: For treatment of localized infestations on patios, decks and non crop areas, spray infested areas thoroughly. Thoroughly treat hills and runways. Repeat application if reinfestations occur. *Vinyl and Aluminum Siding: The application of this product to vinyl and aluminum siding (particularly lightly colored, aged, weathered or otherwise damaged) may result in staining, bleaching or discoloration. Factors such as extreme heat and direct sunlight can promote damage. Before applying to vinyl or aluminum siding, treat a small area and evaluate 30 minutes later to allow any potential staining to occur. Regardless of the test results, do not apply to vinyl or aluminum siding while exposed to direct sunlight or during the heat of the day.*

REFILL INSTRUCTIONS: Use as a refill for an empty container of WILSON[®] READY TO USE ANTOUT[®] (Reg. No. 29723 P.C.P. Act). DO NOT transfer or dilute the solution. Remove the sprayer from the original empty bottle and attach to the refill container by following these steps:

- 1. Remove cap, battery-operated sprayer and holder from original bottle.
- 2. Remove cap from refill bottle.
- 3. Place holder, battery-operated sprayer and cap onto refill bottle and tighten cap.

HOW TO USE SPRAYER:

- A. Aim toward target weeds and away from people and pets.
- B. Press the trigger to spray.
- C. Release the trigger to stop spray.

After use:

- 1. Twist nozzle completely to CLOSE position.
- 2. Secure sprayer upright in holder.
- 3. Failure to adjust nozzle completely to CLOSE position and properly secure sprayer in holder may result in leakage and damage to property or injury to people or animals.

To replace batteries:

- 1. Slide battery compartment door to unlatch and open.
- 2. Remove used batteries and insert new AA batteries *in correct positions* as marked per diagram inside of battery compartment. Never insert the positive end where the negative end belongs and vice versa. Always use a complete set of new batteries of the same type when replacing batteries. *Never* mix alkaline, carbon-zinc or rechargeable batteries.
- 3. Securely close battery compartment door.
- 4. *Always* follow manufacturer's recommendations for use and disposal of batteries.

Additional Operating Notes:

- Do not submerge in water.
- Before each use, inspect sprayer carefully. Make sure hose is flexible and not kinked, worn or cracked, and that all connections are tight.
- When storing sprayer for prolonged periods remove batteries.

REMEMBER ... ALWAYS STORE PESTICIDES, CAPS, SPRAYERS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS.

PRECAUTIONS: Wash thoroughly after handling and before smoking or eating. Avoid contamination of food, feed, cooking utensils or drinking water. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquarium before surface applications. After use and at least one (1) hour drying time, wash all surfaces that may contact food. Do not use on humans. Do not allow people or pets to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry. This product is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to lakes, rivers, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries. Do not contaminate the above mentioned aquatic areas through spray drift, cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Trigger Sprayer is to be used only for this product.
