DIRECTIONS:

Insects controlled: Aphids, earwigs, mealybugs, spider mites, psyllids, rose and pear slugs, soft brown scale and whiteflies.

Use indoors and in greenhouses on houseplants and outdoors on fruits, vegetables, flowers and ornamentals.

Apply to thoroughly cover upper and lower leaf surfaces.

Timing: Repeat weekly until control is observed.

NOT recommended on Ferns, Nasturtiums and Sweet Peas. If in doubt about any delicate plant, such as **roses**, **seedlings** and **transplants**, apply to several leaves as a pretest. Allow sufficient time to determine if plant damage occurs before spraying the entire plant. Do not spray open blooms. Do not apply during full sun or high heat.

REFILL INSTRUCTIONS: Use as a refill for an empty container of WILSON[®] BUG-X[®] INSECTICIDAL SOAP READY TO USE BATTERY POWERED (Reg. No. 30187 P.C.P. Act). DO NOT transfer or dilute the solution. Remove the sprayer from the original empty bottle and attach to the refill container by following these steps:

- 1. Remove cap, battery-operated sprayer and holder from original bottle.
- 2. Remove cap from refill bottle.
- 3. Place holder, battery-operated sprayer and cap onto refill bottle and tighten cap.

HOW TO USE SPRAYER:

- A. Aim toward target and away from people and pets.
- B. Press the trigger to spray.
- C. Release the trigger to stop spray.

After use:

- 1. Twist nozzle completely to CLOSE position.
- 2. Secure sprayer upright in holder.
- 3. Failure to adjust nozzle completely to CLOSE position and properly secure sprayer in holder may result in leakage and damage to property or injury to people or animals.

To replace batteries:

- 1. Slide battery compartment door to unlatch and open.
- 2. Remove used batteries and insert new AA batteries *in correct positions* as marked per diagram inside of battery compartment. Never insert the positive end where the negative end belongs and vice versa. Always use a complete set of new batteries of the same type when replacing batteries. *Never* mix alkaline, carbon-zinc or rechargeable batteries.
- 3. Securely close battery compartment door.
- 4. Always follow manufacturer's recommendations for use and disposal of batteries.

Additional Operating Notes:

- Do not submerge in water.
- Before each use, inspect sprayer carefully. Make sure hose is flexible and not kinked, worn or cracked, and that all connections are tight.
- When storing sprayer for prolonged periods remove batteries.

REMEMBER ... ALWAYS STORE PESTICIDES, CAPS, SPRAYERS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Wash fruits and vegetables before eating. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Trigger Sprayer is to be used only for this product.

FIRST AID: If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: The sprayer is reusable only with WILSON BUG-X INSECTICIDAL SOAP REFILL (Reg. No. 32077). Do not refill the container with any product. Remove used batteries from the sprayer and dispose of appropriately. Recycle empty container.
