DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture (formulating, repackaging, repouring) of a pest control product solely for export from Canada.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL, May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing dust or vapours. Use with adequate ventilation. Causes eye irritation. May cause skin irritation. Do not get into eyes, skin or on clothing. Wear suitable chemical resistant gloves and goggles or face shield when handling. When using, do not eat, drink or smoke. FIRST AID:
