### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Hold container with nozzle aimed away from you. Do not treat when food is present. Clean treated surfaces before being used to prepare food.

#### FOR OUTDOOR USE:

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, hornets and wasps: Direct spray upward with slow sweeping motion, into areas where insects are present.

#### PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not breathe vapours or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Wash hands with soap and warm water after use. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 50°C may cause bursting. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to possibility of shock hazard. TOXIC to bees. #### FIRST AID:

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take the container label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically. Contains petroleum distillates. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not use empty container. When container is empty, press button to release all pressure. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.
