**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

<b>TO CONTROL:</b>	<b>APPLICATION PROCEDURE:</b> Remove cap. Before first use, remove shaker top and remove bottle seal; reapply shaker top. Reapply cap after use.
<u>INDOORS:</u> Ants, Certain beetles, Boxelder bugs, Cockroaches, Crickets, Flies, Flying moths, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Silverfish, Wasps	Gently shake or squeeze the container to lightly coat the areas where insects crawl and hide, especially behind refrigerator and stove. Rate of application is 40 g per 10 square metres of surface area. Hit the insects where possible.
<u>OUTDOORS:</u> Ants, Centipedes, Crickets, Earwigs and Millipedes	Lightly coat the areas where these pests are found or may hide including patios, windows, door frames and sills outside of entrance ways, around foundations and along ant trails. Repeat treatment as necessary.

**PRECAUTIONS:**

**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Do not use as a general space spray. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash hands well after use.
