- 6. Let stand or continue to massage in for 5 minutes.
- 7. Rinse thoroughly to remove all traces of shampoo from the dog's coat.
- 8. Do not use this shampoo more often than once every week. Treatment must be repeated only if the pest problem reoccurs. Do NOT use solely as a shampoo when there is no pest problem.

Consult a veterinarian before using on sick, aged, pregnant or nursing animals or animals receiving drug or other pesticide treatment.

For effective flea and tick control, treatment of the pet should be combined with sanitation of any area used by the pet. Vacuum floors, carpets and furniture (discard vacuum bag after use) and wash the pet's bedding, living quarters and surrounding areas.
