To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide registered under the Pest Control Products Act.

PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Corrosive to eyes and skin. May cause irreversible eye damage. Causes skin and mucous membrane irritation. DO NOT get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. May be harmful if absorbed through the skin. May be fatal if inhaled. DO NOT breathe vapour of concentrate. Fatal or poisonous if swallowed. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Strong oxidizing agent. Mix only with water. INTEROX® M-70 Hydrogen Peroxide is not combustible; however at temperatures exceeding 69° C decomposition occurs releasing oxygen. The oxygen released could initiate or promote combustion of other materials.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration number with you when seeking medical attention.

STORAGE:

Never return INTEROX® M-70 Hydrogen Peroxide to the original container after it has been removed. Store in a properly vented container or in an approved bulk storage facility. Do not block vents. Product should be kept cool and vented to avoid explosion hazard. Since hydrogen peroxide is a strong oxidizing agent, contact with combustibles may cause fire. Store in original containers in a well-ventilated, cool, dry and secure area. Ship and store away from food, fertilizer, feed and seed. Keep containers tightly closed.

PROCEDURE FOR LEAK OR SPILL

Stop leak if this can be done without risk. Shut off ignition sources; no flames, smoking, flares or spark producing tools. Keep combustible and organic materials away. Flush spilled material with large quantities of water. Undiluted material should not enter confined spaces.

DISPOSAL:
