4. [Place the lantern on a flat stable area.] To activate the mosquito repellent, grasp the lantern [collar] [base] and rotate [turn] collar to the right until the [indicator] [arrow] [line] points to “ON” [is in the “ON” position.] The gas will begin to flow
5. Wait approximately 5 to 10 seconds then rotate lantern [collar] [base] further to the right until the [indicator] [arrow] [line] points to “START” [is in the “START” position]. You should hear a clicking noise.
6. To verify that the mosquito repellent is activated look at the [circular] [oval] view hole located [on the lantern] [collar] [lid] to the right of the “START” button. An orange light will glow.
