DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of an herbicide, which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

Avoid contact. Avoid breathing technical dust or fumes. May irritate eyes. Avoid contact with eyes. Potential skin sensitizer. Wash thoroughly after using or before eating or smoking. Wear protective clothing including goggles and respirator when handling technical material.

FIRST AID:

IN CASE OF POISONING, contact a physician or a poison control centre **IMMEDIATELY**. Remove the patient from contaminated area. Keep the patient at rest.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

The treatment of intoxication should be symptomatic and supportive. When the technical has been ingested, carry out gastric lavage with care to prevent aspiration.

DISPOSAL AND DECONTAMINATION:

Canadian formulators of this technical should dispose of unwanted active and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For additional details and the cleanup of spills, contact the provincial regulatory agency or the manufacturer.

STORAGE:
