WHY SHOULD YOU USE THIS PRODUCT:

This product, when used regularly, will prevent the growth of green, black and yellow algae for complete pool enjoyment. For best results, follow our 4 step pool care program.

Step 1: Test and adjust water balance.

Step 2: Sanitize.

Step 3: Shock regularly.

Step 4: Add algaecide as directed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

READ ALL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS BEFORE USE.

This product may be used in the same treatment program as most commonly used pool chemicals, but should not be mixed with any foreign material such as soap or other water treatment chemicals. This product works best when added in several places to the pool with the pump or circulation system running. Wait 15 minutes before entering the pool. Pools with heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using this product.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

- ➤ Initial Dosage: Add 33 mL of HTH Super Algae Guard 30 per 10,000 L of pool water when filling the pool at the beginning of the season.
- ➤ Maintenance Dosage: Add 17 mL HTH Super Algae Guard 30 per 10,000 L of pool water at 3-5 day intervals. If high temperatures prevail or the pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently. If make up water is added at the rate of more than 10% of pool capacity per week, add 17 mL per 10,000 litres of fresh make up water added per week.
- ➤ Visible Algae Dosage: If pool has slight visible algae growth, brush pool surface where algae is present and treat with 67mL HTH Super Algae Guard 30 per 10,000 L of pool water. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or re-appear, repeat this treatment as necessary.
- > When pool is free of visible algae, use the "Maintenance Dose" as above.

DO NOT apply when swimmers are in the immediate vicinity (a 15-minute restricted-entry interval is recommended).

WINTERIZING DOSAGE: When swimming season is over, add the "Initial Dosage" above. This dosage helps to provide a measure of control of algae growth during the winter months and aids the servicing of the pool before it is returned to use the following summer.
