Use trigger spray attachment enclosed. Use this product anytime weeds are actively growing. Wet the foliage using short bursts of spray. Avoid over applying to the point of runoff. Do not apply to drought stressed grass or newly seeded lawns. Do not apply in very hot (over 30°C) or rainy weather, or if rainfall is forecast within the next 2 to 4 hours. Do not water for 2 hours after application. For more resistant weeds, re-apply after 4 to 6 weeks. This product will not prevent new weeds - apply only when weeds are present. Grass that is accidentally treated may temporarily turn brown but will recover.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE OF BATTERY SPRAYER:**

## **EASY SET UP (5 illustrations)**

- 1. Remove sprayer from holder. Gently pull tubing.
- 2. Remove seal from top of cap. Remove plug from cap.
- 3. Securely snap the plug on end of tubing into hole on cap.
- 4. Remove plastic tab to activate batteries.
- 5. Twist nozzle to adjust spray from CLOSE to SPRAY to STREAM.

#### **HOW TO USE**

- A. Aim toward target weeds and away from people and pets.
- B. Press the trigger to spray.
- C. Release the trigger to stop spray.

#### After use:

- 1. Twist nozzle completely to CLOSE position.
- 2. Secure sprayer upright in holder.

## To replace batteries:
