(Option 3) INSTRUCTIONS - BATTERY SPRAY WAND:

EASY SET-UP:

- 1. Remove spray wand from holder. Remove wrap from coiled hose. Remove protective battery strip from handle.
- 2. Remove sticker and cap cover before inserting hose plug.
- 3. Connect hose to cap by inserting plug at end of coiled hose into hole on cap and push firmly until secure.

HOW TO USE:

- A. Open spray wand until fully extended. Adjust spray nozzle to desired setting.
- B. Slide ON/OFF switch to ON position.
- C. Aim toward target pests and away from people and pets.
- D. Squeeze trigger to dispense product. Sprayer may require a couple seconds to prime before product is released.

AFTER USE:

- 1. Slide ON/OFF switch to OFF position.
- 2. Do not unplug hose. Leave connected to cap.
- 3. Turn spray nozzle to the closed position.
- 4. Fold spray nozzle down against handle.
- 5. Return spray wand to holder.

[To replace batteries:

1. Slide battery compartment door to unlatch and open.

2. Remove used batteries and insert new AA batteries in correct positions as marked per diagram inside of battery compartment. Never insert the positive end where the negative end belongs and vice versa. Always use a complete set of new batteries of the same type when replacing batteries. *Never* mix alkaline, carbonzinc or rechargeable batteries.

Additional Operating Notes: •Do not submerge in water. •Before each use, inspect sprayer carefully.
