DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*

NOTICE TO USER:

This pest control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on the label. It is an offence under the *Pest Control Products Act* to use this product in a way that is inconsistent with the directions on the label.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. May be harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid breathing the dust and contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking. Do not contaminate food, feed or any body of water. For good industrial hygiene practice, wear chemical resistant gloves and a dust mask if the product is manually poured.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes, Hold the eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed, Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin, Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse the skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled - Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL:

Canadian manufacturers should dispose of unwanted active ingredients and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For additional details and clean up of spills, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency.

STORAGE:

Store in a cool, dry place away from food or feedstuff, or where children or animals may have access.
