**DIRECTIONS:** Shake well before and occasionally during use.

**TO KILL LICE AND LICE EGGS:** Spray on an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect after drying then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Depress valve and spray from a distance of 20 to 25 cm. Spray each 900 cm<sup>2</sup> for about 3 seconds. For garments and bedding: spray those that cannot be either laundered or dry-cleaned immediately. For mattresses and furniture: spray, then air until completely dry at least 4 hours before re-use. Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment if re-infestation occurs.

**TO KILL BED BUGS:** Spray mattress, particularly around seams and tufts. Take bed apart, spray all joints. Also spray cracks, crevices, baseboards and other possible hiding places around the room. For mattresses: spray, then air until completely dry at least 4 hours before re-use. Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before re-occupying. Repeat as required.

**PRECAUTIONS:** KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate can. Do not use near heat or store at temperatures above 50 °C. Avoid spraying in eyes. May be absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. May cause skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Do not wear treated garments or use bedding until thoroughly cleaned and infestation is eliminated. Intentional misuse by deliberately concentrating and inhaling the contents, can be harmful or fatal.

**FIRST AID:** IF IN EYES, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
