PESTS/SITES:

Controls the following lawn weeds: Dandelion, English daisy, False dandelion, White clover, Black medic, Bull thistle, Canada thistle, Common chickweed, Creeping buttercup, Slender speedwell, Narrow-leaved plantain, Broad-leaved plantain (suppression only), Dove's-foot geranium, Wild geranium, Lawn burweed, Moss, and Algae.

For use on lawn turf consisting of one or more of Kentucky bluegrass, perennial ryegrass, and fescue (tall fescue, chewings fescue, and/or creeping fescue) for control or suppression of broadleaf weeds.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. [[Push/Squeeze] tabs,] [[twist/turn] cap to open.]] [[Squeeze,/ turn,/ press cap] [and turn/ while turning] [to open].] [[Peel/ Pull/ Tear/ off/ Remove] [tamper [resistant/ evident] band [on bottom of cap].] [[To measure the right amount [of product],] [use [the] [convenient] [easy-measure] cap [with] [measuring/ scale/ volume/ gradation[s]] [lines/ markings/ marks] [inside].]

One litre of product will treat between 22.5 and 90 m² (242 and 968 ft²).

Application Directions:

Use with [optional language: the Scotts® Dial 'N Spray® Hose-End Sprayer or] any standard hand-held or backpack sprayer.

[optional language: Scotts® Dial 'N Spray® Hose-End Sprayer*: Set the dial on the Dial 'N Spray® applicator to 55 and go over the application area twice following label directions.]

Hand-held or backpack sprayers:

- -Mix 125 mL of Fiesta 2.0 Broadleaf Weed Killer For Lawns with 1 L water.
- -Use a coarse nozzle setting to reduce drift.
- -Apply the mixed solution at a rate of 100-400 ml/m². The standard rate is 200 ml spray/m²; use the higher rate (400 ml spray/m²) on the following tough perennial weeds: broad-leaved plantain (suppression only), creeping buttercup, and Canada thistle. For Canada thistle, best results are obtained when weeds are less than 15 cm tall.
- Use the lower rate (100 ml spray/m²) on moss, black medic, slender speedwell, wild geranium and on weed seedlings of false dandelion, English daisy, dandelion or white clover.

[optional language: *The Scotts® Dial 'N Spray® Hose-End Sprayer is a hose end sprayer with various settings. The dial setting is the number of mL of product being applied per litre of water. Please refer to the Scotts® Dial 'N Spray® Hose-End Sprayer label for complete use instructions.]

How to Apply:

- Spray weeds until foliage is thoroughly soaked, just to the point of runoff.
- -Uniform coverage is important.
- -A second application may be required. Repeat treatment every three to four weeks if necessary, up to a maximum of 4 applications per area per year.

What to expect:

- -Visible signs of control may be seen within several hours after application.
- -Susceptible weeds, moss or algae will turn brown or black. Occasionally a darkening of the grass leaf blades can occur after treatment; however the grass will recover within a few days to several weeks.
- -May stain thatch (dead grass under lawn); this does not affect the health of the grass.

Use Precautions:

- Do not apply to drought stressed grass; ensure that the lawn is well watered prior to application.
- -Do not apply when the daytime temperature will exceed 30°C.
- -Do not apply to bentgrass. If unsure of grass sensitivity, test spray a small area of your lawn.
- -Do not apply to newly seeded areas until 4 or more weeks after grass seedlings have emerged.
- -Avoid spraying desirable plants. Any desirable plants or structures accidentally contacted should be rinsed immediately with water.
- -To avoid staining, wait until treated area dries before re-entry.
- -Do not apply if rainfall is expected within 3 hours of application.
- -Do not irrigate within 3 hours of application.
- -Do not apply more than 4 times per area per year.
- -DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PRECAUTIONS:

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Causes slight eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco. Wear waterproof gloves during application or during mixing, loading, and repair/clean-up activities. DO NOT get in eyes. Avoid breathing vapour or spray mist. Do not re-enter or allow re- entry into treated areas until the spray is dried. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed:

Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing:

Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 - 20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled:

Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes:

Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 - 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE:

Store this product in its original container and keep in a secure storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Store unused material, tightly closed, in original container only, away from open flame. Protect from freezing. To prevent contamination store this product away from food or feed.
