Troubleshooting: If torch does not turn on, verify that there is no orange [light] [glow] in the view hole. If there is no orange [light] [glow], rotate indicator line back to the “ON” position and repeat rotation to the “START” position two to three times in rapid succession. If there is still no orange [light] [glow] visible in the view hole, make sure the cartridge is completely screwed into place. Also check the amount of fuel in the cartridge. If cartridge is empty or near empty, remove cartridge and replace with a new Thermacell cartridge. Then repeat step #[3]
