DIRECTIONS FOR USE: DO NOT USE ON HORSES INTENDED FOR SLAUGHTER. To protect horses from horn flies, house flies, stable flies, horseflies, deer flies, mosquitoes, and biting midges. Hold 15 to 20 cm (6-8") from the animal while spraying, keeping nozzle pointed away from the head. Apply a light mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair. Do not saturate hair or skin. To control stable flies, horseflies and deer flies, apply Disvap Équin Water Base Insecticide for Horses at a rate of 60 mL per adult animal sufficient to wet the hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection, but not more often than once per day.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat or store at temperatures over 50°C. Do not spray near open flame or spark. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. May be irritant to eyes and mucous membranes. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Remove pets and birds before surface applications. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuff.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to lakes, ponds, streams, marshes or estuaries. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste.

FIRST AID: if swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE: Do not transport or store under 0°C. Store in a place inaccessible to children and pets. Store in a cool dry place. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Protect from freezing.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press valve to release all remaining pressure. Wrap and discard empty container in household garbage.
