Vacate the treated area and keep windows and doors closed for 15 minutes, then ventilate treated areas by opening windows and doors or using fans, where required, to aid in the circulation of air.

OUTDOOR USE: To control house flies, hornets, mosquitoes, and wasps: Adjust nozzle to deliver the mist spray pattern. **DO NOT** apply to overhead areas or in confined spaces (e.g., eaves, soffits). **DO NOT** allow spray to drip or allow drift onto non-target surfaces.

- For use on the exterior surfaces of listed buildings: Apply to structural surfaces of homes, garages, storage buildings, barns, domestic kennels, domestic farm buildings, and domestic stables where insects are congregating, including around windows & doors and other structural surfaces of listed buildings.
