DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

How to apply: SHAKE CAN WELL BEFORE USING. Hold container approximately 30 cm from surface being sprayed and spray until wet. Thorough applications produce a coating which will vaporize into cracks and crevices for insect control. Apply only as an indoor crack and crevice or indoor or outdoor spot treatment. For all uses on this label, **DO NOT** exceed 3 seconds per m². **DO NOT** APPLY AS A SPACE SPRAY, PERIMETER OR BROADCAST TREATMENT. To enhance effectiveness of this product, apply directly to the listed pests where possible. When applied indoors, good sanitary practices should be maintained to prevent re-infestation. Spot application is localized to a surface area not more than 0.2 m². Spots are not to be adjoining. The combined area of spots is not to exceed 10% of the total surface area of a room (indoor) or total surface area treated (outdoors). Crack and crevice is an application directly into narrow openings on the surface of the structure. It does not include the treatment of exposed surfaces. Narrow openings typically occur at expansion joints, utility entry points and along baseboards and mouldings.

Use limitations: **DO NOT** apply when people or pets are present. **DO NOT** allow people or pets to enter treated areas until sprays have dried. **DO NOT** allow spray to drip or allow drift onto non-target surfaces. **DO NOT** apply to people, pets, livestock or sources of electricity. **DO NOT** apply to overhead areas or in confined spaces (e.g., indoors in attics, crawlspaces, small storage rooms, closets; and outdoors to eaves and soffits). **DO NOT** apply to pet bedding, furniture (excluding bookcases and storage furniture), mattresses, linens, toys or clothing. Ventilate treated areas after application by opening windows and doors, or using fans, where required, to aid in the circulation of air. **DO NOT** apply in areas where plants are grown for food or feed (e.g., vegetables, fruits, herbs). **DO NOT** treat soil, turf or other plants adjacent to the treatment site.

INDOOR USE:

To control ants, carpet beetles, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, millipedes, silverfish, sowbugs and spiders: Thoroughly treat indoor building surfaces in hard to reach places, including cracks and crevices in walls, floors and ceilings; along and behind baseboards; around water pipes and tanks; walls behind and floors beneath appliances (e.g., refrigerators and stoves) and furniture (e.g., shelves, drawers, cabinets and storage units); around sinks, drains and pipes; around interior foundations; garbage cans; localized areas of floors and floor coverings; and points of entry (e.g., around windows and doors). Treatment must only be repeated after 7 days if pest problem persists or reoccurs.

To control fleas and brown dog ticks: Apply to indoor building surfaces, including cracks and crevices in walls and floors; along and behind baseboards; window and door frames; and localized areas of floor and floor coverings. **DO NOT** SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. Only treat pets with products specifically registered for use on that type of pet. For effective flea and tick control indoors, clean any area used by the pet. Cleaning the areas includes vacuuming floors, carpets, furniture, etc. (discard vacuum bag after use) and washing the pet's bedding, living quarters and surrounding area. Treatment must only be repeated after 7 days if pest problem persists or reoccurs.

OUTDOOR USE:

To control ants, brown dog ticks, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, fleas, millipedes, sowbugs and spiders, and to kill house flies and cluster flies: For use as a spot treatment only on the exterior surfaces of buildings, garbage cans and on porches, patios and decks. Apply to the outside surfaces of foundations, around light fixtures and places where listed pests enter (e.g., screens, door frames, window frames). House flies and cluster flies will be killed when they land and crawl

on the treated surfaces. Treatment must only be repeated after 14 days if pest problem persists or reoccurs.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. May cause skin and/or eye irritation. **DO NOT** get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Contents under pressure. **DO NOT** place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat, or store at temperatures over 50 °C. **DO NOT** spray on plastic, painted or varnished surfaces or directly into any electronic equipment such as radios, televisions, computers, etc. **DO NOT** apply to surfaces that may come into contact with food/feed. Cover or remove all food/feed. Cover all food/feed processing surfaces, equipment and utensils or thoroughly wash them following treatment. Any food/feed accidentally contaminated with spray solution must be discarded.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS: Toxic to aquatic organisms, birds, bees and beneficial arthropods (which may include predatory and parasitic insects, spiders and mites). Minimize exposure to non-target areas and avoid application around blooming plants. If applications must be made during the blooming period, restrict applications to evening when most bees are not foraging. **DO NOT** apply to any body of water. **DO NOT** contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Avoid application of this product when winds are gusty.

FIRST AID: **If swallowed**, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give **any** liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If in eyes**, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If on skin or clothing**, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If inhaled**, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Skin exposure may cause transient sensations (tingling, burning, itching, numbness). Other symptoms of exposure could include respiratory effects (such as cough, respiratory irritation, or shortness of breath), nausea, headache or dizziness. This product contains petroleum distillates. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE: Store this product away from food or feed.
