DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of an antimicrobial product which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Fatal, if swallowed. CORROSIVE TO THE EYE. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Fatal or poisonous if absorbed through the skin. May be fatal if inhaled. Avoid breathing dust. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid dust formation. Wear goggles or face shield, water proof gloves, long sleeved shirts and long legged pants, shoes and socks when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before use. Toxic to fish and wildlife.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE:

Keep in original container during storage. Store product in cool, dry, well ventilated place away from seed, feed, fertilizer or other pesticides. Keep away from fire or open flame or other source of heat. Exercise due caution to prevent damage to or leakage from the container.
